PURPOSE: This legislation, if approved, will approve reinstatement of Colen Nicklis Atene as an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation.

FINAL AUTHORITY: Navajo Nation Council

VOTE REQUIRED: Simple Majority Vote

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review the proposed resolution in detail.

18	A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §	
19	102(A).	
20	B. A proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be	
.21	assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).	
22	D. Any enrolled member of the Navajo Nation may renounce his or her membership	
23	through written petition to the President of the Navajo Nation requesting his or her name	
24	be stricken from the Navajo Nation census roll. However, reinstatement of membership	
25	with the Navajo Nation is permitted, provided such reinstatement is approved by

30	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. Colen Nicklis Atene was previously enrolled with the Navajo Nation, "being of ¾ degree Navajo Indian Blood." See **Exhibit A**, official record containing census number and Certificate of Navajo Indian Blood recorded December 23, 1998 by the Navajo Nation Vital Statistics Manager.
- B. Colen Nicklis Atene relinquished membership with the Navajo Nation and enrolled with the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe. However, Colen Nicklis Atene disenrolled with the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe. On April 14, 2021, the Duckwater Shoshone Tribal Council, by resolution number 2021-D-11 officially approved his disenrollment. See Exhibit B, resolution of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe numbered 2021-D-11. By this action, Colen Nicklis Atene's "benefits and privileges ... enjoyed as a member of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe" were effectively revoked.
- C. On September 25, 2021, the Oljato Chapter, in response to request for reinstatement, passed resolution OLJ09-02-2021-NB2, "SUPPORTING ... REINSTATEMENT OF COLEN NICKLIS ATENE AS A MEMBER OF THE NAVAJO NATION." See Exhibit C, Oljato Chapter Resolution.
- D. Colen Nicklis Atene is eligible for reinstatement as a member of the Navajo Nation.

SECTION THREE. REINSTATEMENT OF COLEN NICKLIS ATENE

The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves the reinstatement of Colen Nicklis Atene as an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation. Colen Nicklis Atene shall hereinafter be entitled to all rights, benefits and privileges associated with Navajo Nation membership.

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE DUCKWATER SHOSHONE TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO, 2021-D-10

- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DUCKWATER TRIBAL COUNCIL, the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe is organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, as amended, to exercise certain rights of home rule and be responsible for the general welfare of its membership; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe, Article II Membership, Section 1, (a) states "All persons of Shoshone Indian blood whose names appear on the Carson Agency census roll of the Duckwater Shoshone Indians dated January 1, 1941, or on the Commissioner's memorandums of registration dated November 28, 1940, or February 20, 1950, or April 26, 1966.", and Section 1 (b) states, "All persons of at least one-quarter (1/4) degree Shoshone Indian blood born to a member who is a descendant of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe and who make application for enrollment in accordance with the enrollment ordinance adopted under Article II, Section 3 of this Constitution."; and
- WHEREAS, the Duckwater Tribal Enrollment Committee determined that in Ordinance for Enrollment, Section 305: Grounds for Disenrollment: B. Failure to meet prescribed enrollment requirements and erroneously enrolled with the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe by the adoption of Resolution No. 03-D-30; and
- WHEREAS, any and all benefits or privileges bestowed on Colen N. Atene as a member of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe are herein revoked as Mr. Atene is no longer eligible to receive such benefits and privileges; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Duckwater Tribal Council has determined that on recommendation of the Duckwater Tribal Enrollment Committee the Tribal Council has disenrolled Colen N. Atene as a member of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe and revoked any and all benefits and privileges he enjoyed as a member of the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution 2021-D-10 shall supersede any and all prior Resolutions and action regarding the enrollment issues for Colen N. Atene and Resolution No. 03-D-30 is herein rescinded.

RESOLUTION OF THE OLIATO CHAPTER

RESOLUTION NO.: OL109-02-2021-NB2

SUPPORTING RESOLUTION OF THE OLIATO CHAPTER FOR THE REINSTATEMENT OF COLEN N. ATENE AS A MEMBER OF THE NAVAJO NATION.

WHEREAS:

- Pursuant to N.N.C., § 4001 (D) and 4028 (A)(B), the Oljato Chapter is established and certified a local government entity of the Navajo Nation vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the Chapter and submit appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation government or other local agencies by resolution; and
- The Oljato Chapter recognizes that under the laws of the Navajo Nation, any enrolled member of the Navajo Nation may renounce [his] membership by written petition to the President of the Navajo Nation requesting that his name be stricken from the Navajo Nation roll, 1 N.N.C. §705.
- 3. The Navajo Nation in addition states, "[no] person, otherwise eligible for membership in the Navajo Nation, may enroll as a member of the Navajo Nation, who, at the same time, is not enrolled with another Indian tribe, 1 N.N.C. §703.
- 4. The Oliato Chapter also recognizes that renounced members may be reinstated by the Navajo Nation only by the vote of majority of the Navajo Nation Council, 1 Navajo Nation Code § 705.
- 5. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records has issued a Certificate of Indian Blood dated December 23, 1998, attached, confirming Colen N. Atene was enrolled with the Navajo Nation on December 23, 1998 and provide

 Census Number. See attachment.
- 6. The Navajo Nation Office of Vital Records has further confirmed Colen N. Atene is three-fourth (3/4) degree Navajo blood and therefore, is eligible for re-enrollment as a member with the Navajo Nation, 1 N.N.C. § 701 (B).
- 7. The Duckwater Shoshone Tribe has confirmed Colen N. Atene formally relinquished his Duckwater Shoshone Tribe membership on April 14, 2021. See attachment, The Duckwater Shoshone Tribal Resolution No.: 2021-D-10.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Oliato Chapter supports the request to reinstate, or otherwise re-enroil, Colen N. Atene as a member of the Navajo Nation By this action of the Oliato Chapter and pursuant to the laws of the Navajo Nation, shall be entitled to all rights, benefits and privileges associated with membership with the Navajo Nation.
